ENGAGEMENT OF KEY ACTORS

INVESTMED structures an engagement process to involve the main target groups incubators, accelerators, clusters, MSMEs, start-ups, investors and decision makers.

TRAIN AND COACH ENTREPRENEURSHIP

INVESTMED launches a training and coaching programme addressed to 315 entrepreneurs to increase their sustainability capacity, creativity and competitiveness. Awards will be provided in the process.

PITCH AND SUBGRANT GREEN & CREACTIVE BUSINESSES INITIATIVES

INVESTMED launches a Sub-granting Call to provide financial support to innovative green and creative initiatives. A total amount of 625,000€ will be subgrant to 38 MSMEs and 3 BSOs.

IMPROVE IPR REGULATORY FRAMEWORK

INVESTMED encourages public authorities to get trained on IPR and to facilitate the access and application of IPR to innovative business services and products.
